Une synthèse de la bibliographie sera présentée corroborée par plus de 35 ans de pratique clinique. Les difficultés liées à l'état initial du patient, la prévention des pathologies articulaires et neuro-musculaires et le rétablissement des fonctions élémentaires de l'occlusion font de cette étape la conclusion thérapeutique du traitement.

Nous vous proposerons une attitude thérapeutique, une liste de recommandations et de critères que nous appliquerons à l'examen de cas cliniques par analyse sur articulateur et informatique. Ce dernier moyen permet par sa simplicité de contrôler de façon commode notre qualité de travail.

La séance s'articulera autour du diagnostic dans un premier temps, puis des séquences de traitement dans un second temps: les praticiens auront la possibilité de donner leur avis sur les options thérapeutiques qui ont été prises.

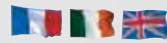

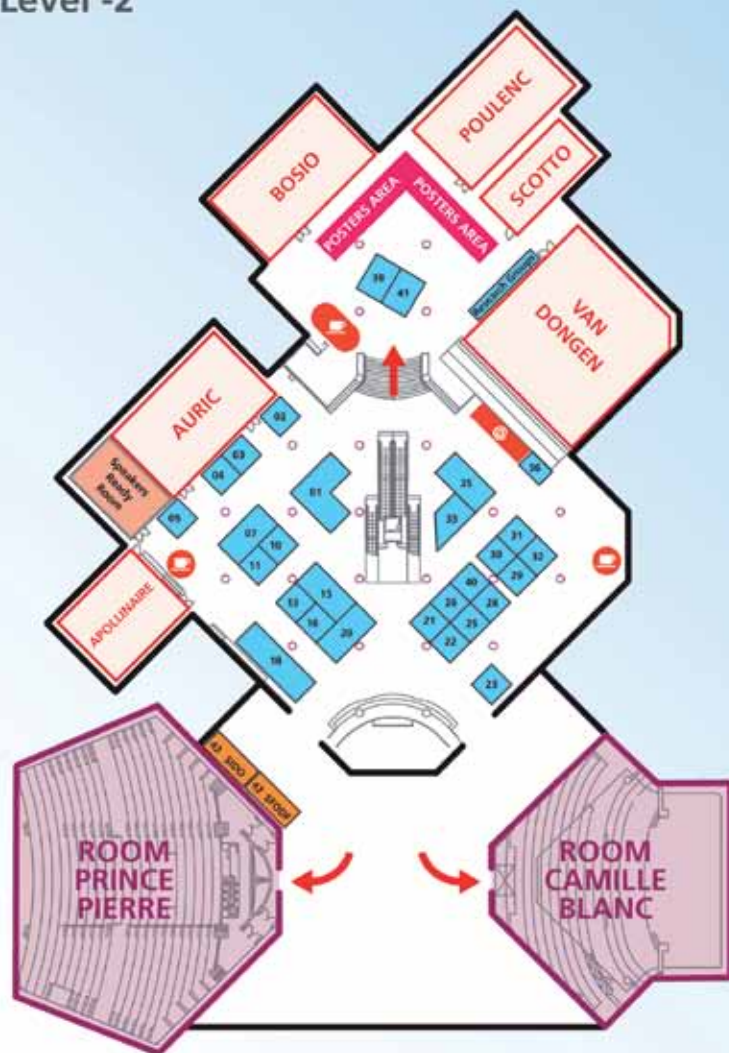
